Introducing Faculty of Architecture



The Faculty of Architecture, Chiang Mai University (ARCH CMU), opened its doors as a major centre of architectural education in the northern region of Thailand in June 1995. Established within one of the most prestigious Faculties of Fine Arts in Thailand, the department of Architecture then established its pedagogical philosophy with the first group of students in the academic year of 1995-1996. After a couple of years of innovative approach in teaching, learning and researching Architecture, the Faculty of Architecture, on the 3rd of June 2000, was completely authorized to take on faculty status.



Since then, ARCH CMU has attained a reputation for a high standard of teaching, learning and researching Architecture and ARCH CMU has gradually become one of the top Architectural Schools in Thailand. ARCH CMU does not believe in teaching Architecture per se, but rather recognizes that it is our teaching philosophy's ambition to unfold the main ideas, approaches and methodologies for students to understand Architecture as well as the process of architectural intervention and innovation (with the support of associated fundamental research, techniques and theory). It is our aim to guide students to become themselves and develop their ability to think critically and work effectively and creatively. Students will familiarize themselves with the history and the development of global architecture with the concentration on the integration of traditional Thai-Lanna and global Architecture.

We have our long term goal to pioneer ARCH CMU as a centre of excellent education within the region and to lead our students to the highest ability with the use of ARCH CMU as a laboratory to help them grow into the leaders in their fields. Students will develop their skills and intellectual abilities so as to be able to approach formal and informal design challenges. ARCH CMU will help them to continue with further innovations of their ideology and architectural design process. We probe, push, interrogate and ensure that students acquire not just the fundamentals of their field, but also the ability to articulate critically, to see the broader implications of their design proposition and to deeply understand the design process in which they are engaged.

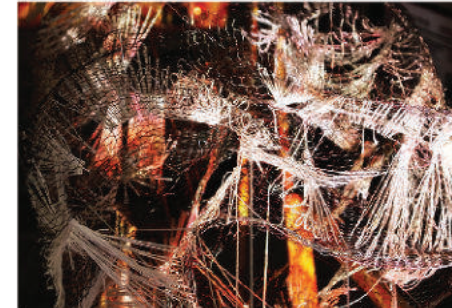

Integrated Design in Emerging Architecture (IDEA) is a 4-year Bachelor of Science (B.Sc) English language international program offered by the Faculty of Architecture, Chiang Mai University. Situated in the oldest higher education institution in the region and surrounded by a culturally and historically vibrant urban backdrop, the program is dedicated to nurture students' critical thinking and independent design capabilities with the knowledge of the latest digital design and fabrication skills that are increasingly being sort-after in the architectural and design community both locally and overseas.

With a particular focus on innovation and experimental design, the 4-year curriculum aims to ground up students' architectural design knowledge from an interdisciplinary approach that include social, physical, life sciences and beyond. Throughout their studies, students will integrate diverse design values from a wide range of creative design industries, whilst the unit system in each year offer varies opportunities for students to investigate and develop their creative thinking process behind their production outcomes. The program is formulated from the belief in creative design values that lead to the core of any principles in design businesses that require an innovative thinking approach.





As Chiang Mai is emerging to become a key player in the local and global creative industry, the IDEA course is perfectly suited to provide its graduates with the best opportunities to develop a successful creative design career and become future leaders in these lines of design-value-oriented businesses. Furthermore, the program is constructed in the dialectic forms of knowledge and practice with creative experimentations in order for students to understand the value process of architectural and spatial design. The program will give special emphasis on teaching, training and communication in English, with a dedicated team of international design academics and practitioners and the opportunity to take part in internship abroad in the latter part of the course in order for students to build the best design thinking foundation for their further studies and interests after graduation.

The goal of this program is to produce highly qualified graduates that can meet the design challenges in the twenty-first century, where an increasing demand of interdisciplinary skills from digital fabrication, creative thinking to biomimicry are required to push the boundaries of architecture design. Graduates of the IDEA program will be educated and trained to become future leaders in design offices both in Thailand and worldwide. The interdisciplinary approach also means that upon graduating, the program will prepare students who wish to continue their graduate studies overseas.

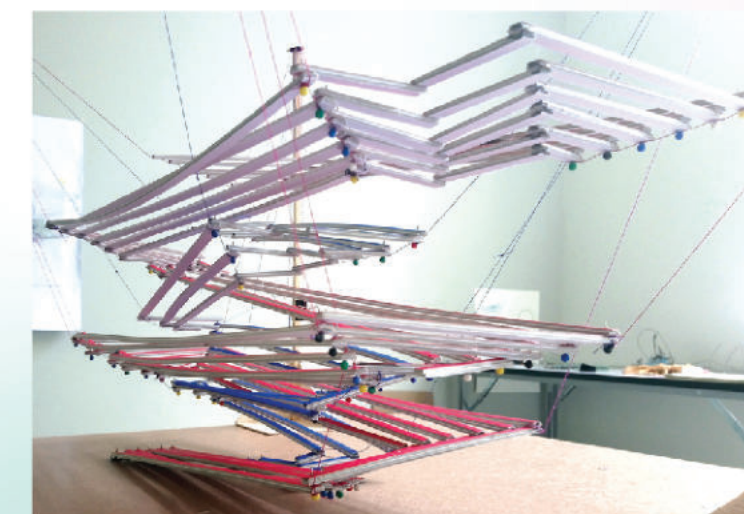
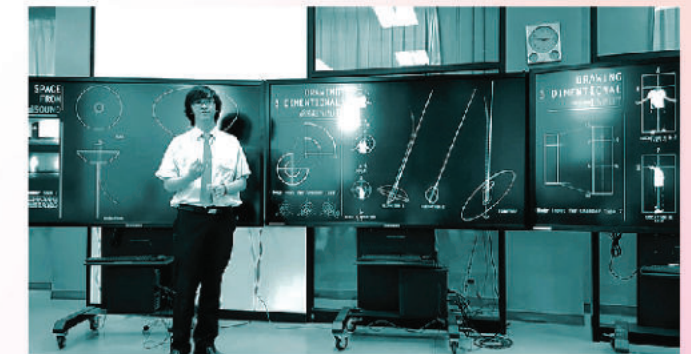

Master of Architecture Program in Architecture (International Program) is a collaboration between the Faculty of Architecture and the Graduate School of Chiang Mai University, Thailand and the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Kyoto Institute of Technology, Japan.

The International Joint Master Degree Program in Architecture is a 2-year (four semesters) program providing enrolled students with 48 credits of course works, research and design in the facilitative contexts of Chiang Mai and Kyoto campuses.



Program Information

Philosophy

The Master of Architecture Program (International Program) emphasizes advanced architectural design and research that apply traditional wisdoms and body of knowledge to solve current and future problems and respond to present and future contexts. Aiming at integrating architecture studies with related fields, the program is designed to tackle the current regional and global issues which confront our built environments today meanwhile searching for sustainable alternatives for ongoing future problems and dynamics.





Research Platform : Diverse Expertise

Our research platform is largely divided into two tiers: tradition and innovation. The first one, tradition, explores the theoretical and empirical contexts of architecture and environment through documentary and field-based research. The second one, innovation, explores technological advancement in planning and design of the built environment. These two tiers are overlapped and interrelated, and the students can build up their research based on the combined two tiers. Our 20+ PhD staff comprise of diverse expertise ranging from architectural theories, vernacular architecture studies (specializing Thai, Lanna Southeast Asia and Asia), urban studies (urban architecture/urban planning /urban conservation), environmental planning and management (restorative/well-being/healing environments), aging society and universal design, energy conscious and tropical design, building and material technology (bamboo/timber/renewable materials), climate change and disaster management.

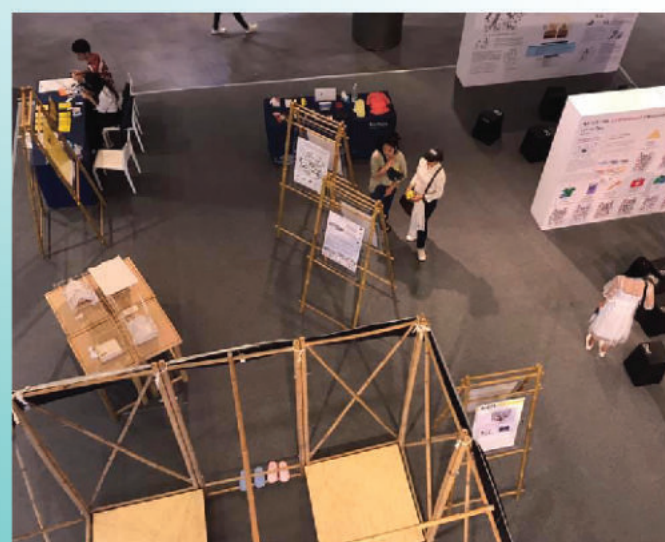

Our Facilities

Wood and Metal Laboratory

Lanna Architecture Center

Lanna Architecture Center is situated on Klang Wiang Intersection of Chiang Mai city in an around 120-year-old building and is looked after by the Faculty of Architecture. The center is used for conducting research as well as for collecting and publishing Lanna architectural and cultural knowledge.

Opening hours: Tuesday to Saturday 08.30 - 16.30.
Closed on Sundays and Mondays.



Studios

The studios are provided for students of each year to work on their designs and projects.



Smart Classroom

Smart Classroom, located on the faculty's 3rd floor, is designed to be a lecture and presentation room. With the use of Interactive Board, many forms of presentation could be conducted.



Auditorium

The auditorium is a large meeting hall located on the faculty's 3rd floor with seating for around 400. The auditorium is used to conduct faculty's teaching and learning activities as well as other special educational events.



The 21st Century Learning Center

It is a meeting and co-working space located on the faculty's 1st floor. The area consists of a coffee shop and a large working space. It is sometimes turned into a place to organize learning and teaching events as well.



Faculty of Architecture Chiang Mai University Alumni Association Office

It is an area for the Faculty of Architecture Alumni Association to use in conducting alumni activities as well as for current students' activities and other events organized by the faculty. The office is located on the faculty's 1st floor.



Computer Laboratory

CMU Cooperative is a convenience store that offers reduced prices for routine stationary items, general household supplies, and foodstuffs.

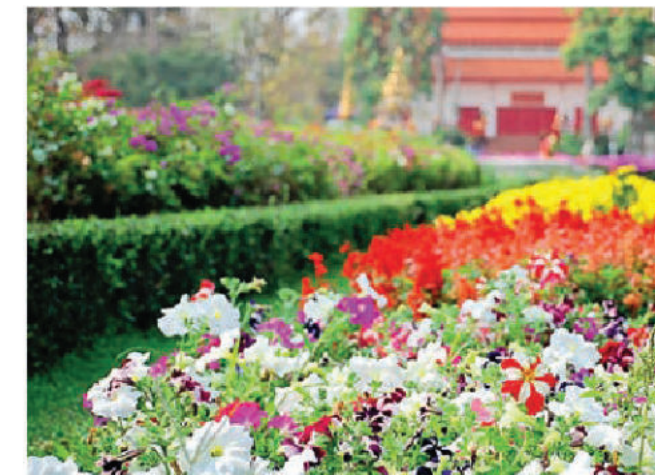

Health Services

A first-aid clinic for staff and students, located next to the CMU Faculty Club, is open weekdays, excluding public holidays, from 08.30-16.30. The Student Health Service, at the Faculty of Medicine, also provides medical care on Saturday and Sunday, from 10.00 - 12.00 and 13.30 - 15.30.

Athletic and Recreational Facilities

Many sporting fields, indoor and outdoor athletic courts, fitness parks, and a 50-meter swimming pool are located on the main campus. The Students Union organizes many student clubs that are devoted to utilizing these facilities for sporting, athletic, and social activities.

Transport Services – On campus and to the city

The University operates a fleet of 50 electric-powered vehicles which run on set routes around the campus. In addition, privately owned red pick-ups and three-wheeled "tuk tuks", are available for students to go around and between the campuses and to destinations in the city.

Counseling Services

Students with problems of a more personal nature on issues related to their academic studies, can seek assistance at the Counseling Center, which is staffed and managed by lecturers from the Psychology Department. The Center is located in the Faculty of Humanities and is open on weekdays, from 09.00 - 15.00.
